The 17th edition of the International Conference on Renewable Resources and Biorefineries (RRB 2021) was held from 6-8 September 2021 in Aveiro, Portugal and very well organized by Christian Stevens

Session topics dealt with biobased and biodegradable materials, biocatalysis, bioenergy, biorefining, chemical platform molecules, carbon dioxide capture and utilisation, Horizon 2020/Horizon Europe, marine bioeconomy, novel fermentation processes, nutrient recycling, polysaccharides and sustainability analysis.
